The Principal recommends the following change to school policy:

Add the following to paragraph III. C. on page 24 of the Family Handbook:

***** CUT LINE *****

Students who have 5 unexcused absences or 5 tardies at any time throughout the school year may not be permitted to:

- Participate in school field trips
- Attend school dances
- Receive student-of-the-quarter or honor or high honor roll awards
- Serve on student government
- Participate in extra-curricular activities and programs
- Participate in school sports

***** CUT LINE *****

This would mirror the APS policy below.

“Students who are absent five [5] days and/or tardy five [5] days at any time throughout the school year may not be permitted to –

- Participate in school field trips
- Attend school dances
- Serve as a Student-of-the-Month
- Serve as a School Safety Officer
- Serve as Student Government Association Representative
- Participate in our School’s Talent or Fashion Show
- Participate in extracurricular activities and programs”
