



Spirit Day Dress Code

Spirit Day is a once-a-month opportunity for students to dress more casually and show their school spirit! Like a corporate “casual dress day”, students should think of their spirit day dress as professional casual.

The Spirit Day dress code is as follows:

Permitted:

- Tops and outerwear: Only ACA Spirit Wear (clothing issued by the school with an ACA/Cavalier logo)
- Black, blue, or gray athletic shorts
 - Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms hang straight and must be an acceptable color (see below)
- Jeans, Khakis, Chinos, Cargo, and any **non-athletic** pants
 - Brown, black, white, blue, and gray colors
- Uniform skirts
- Jr. Cavs Cheer Uniforms are permitted, as are Varsity and JV cheer warm-up suits
- Beginning in the second semester, seniors only may wear a T-shirt or sweatshirt of a college on Spirit Day
- If a student prefers to opt out of Spirit Wear, they may wear their regular uniform

Not Permitted:

- Leggings, sweatpants (or sleepwear of any kind), sweat pant-style joggers, transparent clothing, or clothing with holes, rips, or tatters
- Hats, face paint, hair dye, or tattoos
- Tank tops, or sleeveless shirts, ACA-branded singlets
- Non-uniform skirts
- Regular clothing that is not uniform or Spirit Wear
- Shoes must conform to normal ACA uniform standards (school or neutral colors)

For themed spirit days and Spirit Week, exceptions to this dress code will be stated in the theme for the day. No other deviations from this code are acceptable.
