Meeting Minutes: December 22, 2017

A special meeting of Northside Education Inc. dba Atlanta Classical Academy was held on December 22, 2017 at 8 a.m. at Atlanta Classical Academy, 3260 Northside Drive, N.W., Atlanta, GA 30327, the Board Chair being in the chair and the Secretary being present.

In attendance: Board Chair Matthew Kirby, Dr. Lee Friedman, Scott Yates, Cat McAfee, Amanda Kresch and Principal Steve Lambert. With the majority of the directors in office in attendance, a quorum was established for the transaction of business.

The motion is to approve the agenda for the December 22, 2017 meeting.

Vote: Unanimous approval

### Search committee update

a. Ms. Mooney, Search Committee Co-Chair, contacted five firms and three submitted proposals: Carney Sandoe, Educators Collaborative, and Wickenden Associates. Fees range from \$35,000 to \$60,000. The firm proposing the highest price was not able to deliver by a July deadline. The firm with the lowest price appeared not to have adequate direct experience. The third firm, Carney Sandoe, has worked for several local private schools including Westminster, Lovett, and Holy Innocents. This firm has done 130 charter school searches, including three recent classical charter school searches. The Search Committee Co-Chair recommended contracting with Carney Sandoe.

The motion is to proceed with a third-party search firm rather than in-house search firm.

The motion is to authorize the Board Chairman as head of the Search Committee to retain Carney Sandoe subject to final review of contracts and reference checks, the contract cost not to exceed \$50,000.00 plus reasonable expenses.

## **Fundraising update**

a. The Chairman gave an update on fundraising strategy and made the following motion:

The motion is to confirm that the school leader is responsible for allocating pledges and gifts to the general and capital funds, and for otherwise adhering to Board Policy and the Principal's Financial and Gift Acceptance Policies.

b. The motion is to receive two documents related to accreditation: School Improvement Plan and School Quality Factors.

### Strategic update

a. Board Chairman has been invited three times to meet with the executives of a local redevelopment authority. Their team visited Atlanta Classical on Friday, December 8. This week, he was presented with a very high-quality land plan in their community that includes space for a K-12 school. The local redevelopment authority is seeking a local charter school operator to support its redevelopment efforts. There is and has been no discussion of moving Atlanta Classical Academy. What has been discussed is the possibility of creating a second campus or school to serve students and families in another community in Atlanta. The Chairman will bring updates to the board as details develop.

- 2) To the best knowledge and belief of the undersigned, no other matters than those of a purely personal and/or nongovernmental nature were discussed during said executive session.
- 3) By executing this affidavit, the undersigned does hereby state that he/she in no way waives any rights granted under the 5th Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- 4) This affidavit is executed solely for the purpose of compliance with the mandate of O.C.G.A. § 50-14-4(b) and shall serve no other purpose.


