Collaborative Keyboarding

This after-school class is designed to equip students with the ability and confidence to accompany one of the school choirs or collaborate with other student singers or instrumental ensembles. Students will also learn how to thoroughly prepare a piece for performance and present themselves with composure. It is intended for students who

have prior piano experience and who can read music notation. This is not intended to replace your private lessons.
