## **Atlanta Classical Academy Dress Code for 2019 High School Prom**

### Ladies:

- Formal Attire required.
- High-low dresses (with the shortest hem no more than 4" above the knee) and full-length gowns are allowed. Cocktail-length dresses are not permitted.
- Gowns can be strapless if they are properly fitting and adhere to the other dress code requirements.
- Gowns may not be cut below the top of the bust line. There should be no cleavage showing from top of the gown, or no loose-fitting gowns that gape open when leaning forward. Plunging necklines are not permitted. The bust line continues around your sides directly under the armpit. With arms down at your side, if flesh touches flesh below the bust line, the dress is not permitted.
- Gowns may be backless or have back cutouts as long as they are not lower than the elbow/navel. Dresses may not be loose fitting in a way that would expose the bottom at any time (sitting, standing, dancing).
- Undergarments must not be visible.
- Two-piece gowns are not acceptable.
- Gowns may not have a slit that exceeds 4" above the knee.
- Front and side midriff may not be exposed with or without mesh

### Gentlemen:

- Black tie only (tuxedo or dark suit)
- No open toed shoes/sandals
- Tennis shoes/athletic shoes/ boots are not acceptable

**These requirements will be strictly enforced at the dance. Students (Boy or Girl) will be turned away at the door if they violate the dress code. No refunds will be given.**
