



Spirit Day Dress Code

Spirit Day is a once-a-month opportunity to students to dress more casually and show their ACA school pride! Spirit Days take place on the first Friday of every month unless otherwise specified. Please contact Mr. Schepps, assistant upper school principal (aschepps@atlantaclassical.org) with any questions regarding Spirit Day.

The Spirit Day dress code is as follows:

- **Tops and outerwear:** Only ACA Spirit Wear (clothing issued by the school with an ACA/Cavalier logo) is permitted. (No singlets)
- Black, blue, or gray **athletic shorts** are permitted. Any color non-athletic shorts, skorts, or pants are permitted.
- Shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when arms hang straight. Skirts must be no shorter than three inches above the knee.
- **Not permitted:** open-toe or open-back shoes, leggings, sweatpants, transparent clothing, or clothing with holes. No hats, face paint, or tattoos.
- Jr. Cavs Cheer Uniforms are permitted, as are Varsity and JV cheer warm-up suits.
- Beginning in the second semester, **seniors** only may wear a T-shirt or sweatshirt of a college on Spirit Day.
- If a student prefers to **opt out of Spirit Wear**, they may wear their regular uniform. They may not wear regular clothing that isn't their uniform or Spirit Wear.
